

Heavy Vehicle Speeding Reform Information Sessions

New laws to address heavy vehicle (trucks and buses) speed compliance are soon to be introduced in Victoria.

The new laws aim to reduce fatalities and injuries involving speeding heavy vehicles and will affect all off-road parties who can influence speeding, such as employers, contractors, operators, schedulers, consignors, receivers and loading managers. If you are one of the parties in the transport chain, then you need to come to one of the information sessions.

The **free** information sessions are being run by VicRoads to help you understand your responsibilities and how to meet your obligations under the new laws.

The sessions will provide an overview of the speeding heavy vehicle reform, and an opportunity to ask questions.
