CONSTRUCTION OF KARINIE STREET ROUND-ABOUT, SWAN HILL
TRAFFIC – DETOUR AT MURRAY VALLEY HIGHWAY & NYAH ROAD

As you may be aware, the construction works of a new roundabout at the intersection of the Murray Valley Highway, Nyah Road, Karinie Street and Curlewis Street commenced Thursday 15 October 2009.

Access to Karinie Street and the Nyah Road through the intersection will be closed until the completion of the works, with access to the industrial area via Saleyards Road from the north and Thurla Street from the south.

Access from Saleyards Road to the front section of the livestock Selling Complex (loading and unloading areas) has been provided via the rear of the Saleyards. The entrance is through the rear gates in which you will then follow the roadway around. A temporary exit route onto Saleyards Road has also been provided adjacent to the front of the Saleyards Canteen.

While the construction of the roundabout is in progress, Livestock Transporters, Agents, major buyers and other key players in this industry are encouraged to use this route.

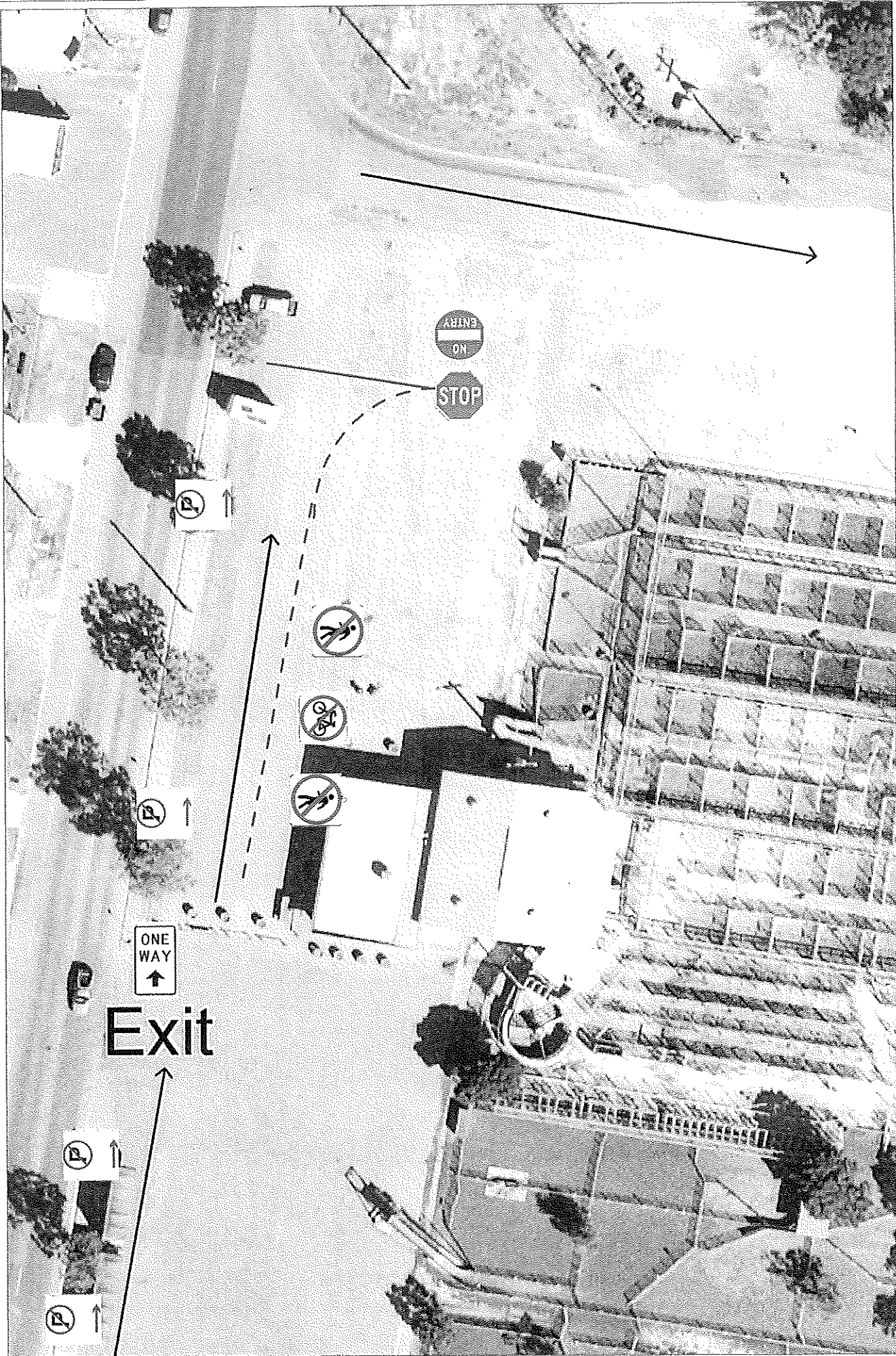
Local Businesses along Karinie Street are reminded not to park their vehicles in areas that are affected by this temporary traffic detour.
